

Setting Restrictions

- Go to Settings
- Select General
- Select Restrictions
- Set a 4 digit passcode (write it down to remember it)
- Scroll through the list of apps you want to add restrictions to



Allowed content allows you to limit content available to the user

- Apps restrictions keeps apps in an age range you select from being downloaded
- Websites restrictions keeps Safari from loading certain types of content or certain websites or from going to the Internet at all

Privacy you can limit what changes can be made to the device

Look under **Game Center**

- multiplayer games can be restricted so the user is not playing against others on the Internet
- Add friends keeps the user from adding friends to the Game Center account

Restrictions remain in effect until you select disable restrictions and enter your passcode
